- 3. President's Report
  - Heather attended the North Dakota Society of Professional Land Surveyors (NDSPLS) AGM last week and is presently at the Montana Association of Registered Land Surveyors (MARLS) AGM
  - Both states have systems that are similar but still very different than ours, but they are experiencing some of the same challenges. They have both seen reduced enrollment in geomatics programs, but are still graduating 20 30 students per state.
  - NDSPLS and MARLS are focused on member services, with regulation and licensing done at the state level. Land surveyors have the option of joining the society. MARLS has 416 members and a population about the same as Saskatchewan.
  - They use the Public Land Survey System, which is similar to the Dominion Land Survey System in reverse and without road allowances. Of course, their terrain is very different.
  - There was a presentation on Riparian Rights. Heather will share the slide deck along with some court cases.
  - Heather will also be attending the AOLS AGM March 1-3 and ABCLS AGM Mar 7-10.
