The Government Policy Review Committee was established by Council in April, 2021 in response to concerns raised by members who feel that government policies and practices do not align with their standards of practice and code of ethics and out of a general concern that the general public may be negatively affected. The committee has identified the following issues as high priorities because of the negative impact on the public:

- Status of monuments in areas subject to ground movement
- Water boundaries as outlined in the Plan Preparation & Procedure Manual and the inconsistencies between the way the province of Saskatchewan handles water boundaries and the commonly accepted legal practices elsewhere across Canada

The committee wishes to update the membership on the progress made to date and will provide a time for questions, comments and will be looking for feedback on our next steps and future committee work.

SLSA Council conducted a survey of members this fall about undertaking a third-party regulatory review similar to the one undertaken by ALSA. Based on the survey results, Council has decided not to undertake an external review at this time. Instead, it has identified 10 of the recommendations made to the ALSA that may be applicable to the SLSA.
